

Fundraising

OPMC is fundraising for a mosque/community center in the greater Oak Park area.

Alhamdulillah, our fundraising has allowed us to collect a total of \$47,000 so far.

The board is actively striving to bring in \$30,000 as a 'personal' board fundraising goal by the end of this August.



The most recent LaunchGood campaign that started this past Ramadan 2024 extends until August 31st--looking to fundraise \$200,000.

The next goal is \$500,000 to \$600,000 by 2025 that will allow us to better target a location for possible purchase.

The ultimate goal is to secure \$2 million by January 2026, inshaAllah.

The Month of Muharram & Ashura

Monday, July 8th was the beginning of the Islamic new year. It is in this month that the Prophet Muhammad (S) deemed important for fasting.

Ashura - The 10th day of Muharram will be this Tuesday, July 16.

"There are four things which the Prophet never gave up: fasting Ashura, fasting during the ten days [of Dhul Hijjah], fasting three days of each month, and praying two rak'at before alghadah [i.e., Fajr]." [Sunan Al-Nasa'i #2416]
